Public Days: Sat. Sept. 25 and Sun. Sept. 26, 10am to 5pm, the entire camp open to visit. Monday- Friday 9/27-10/1, 10am to 5pm **is open only** to the merchants area. **Escorted Candlelight Walking Tour Tues. 9/28, 7:30pm.** **Public day fee:** \$4.00 each adult. Seniors over 65, \$2.00. Children under 18yrs. And military with ID, free of charge. Persons in approved pre-1840 dress can come in all days at daily rate. \$1.00 to park, that benefits 4-H shooting club. Please, do not enter any tent in primitive area without permission, these are our homes. Approved Service animals Only. Follow 'EPR' orange signs at St. Rt 43, North of Carrollton and South of Malvern, Ohio.

Primitive Participants Attendance at a primitive event means: ALL clothing, lodges, and accoutrements must be in the period of 1640 to 1840 North America. Absolutely no modern footwear or sunglasses, unless medically required. Period eyewear is encouraged. Modern shooters eye and ear protection is allowed on the firing line only! All modern items (coolers, cans, bottles, plastic, cell phones, cameras, etc) must be kept out of sight at all times. Turn Cell phone ringers off, or on vibrate while in camp. Handicapping participants must abide by the rules as much as they can. Handicap carts, walkers and registered Service animals are allowed.

NO propane, kerosene heaters, Coleman lanterns, and charcoal lighter fluid will be permitted. Food vendors are one of two exceptions. Cover cameras when not in use, please do not use flash at night. All NRLHF rules apply.

Set up: Wed & Thu, Sept. 22-23, pre-registered, no early set up fee, not registered is \$5.00 per person per day early fee. Gate time 8am to 5pm.

Gate hours: 8am to 6:30pm, Friday 9/24 and Saturday 9/25 ONLY. Sunday 9/26- Saturday 10/02, 8am to 5pm. As always, there will be a 1 hour time limit for unloading and loading vehicles starting at 8am Saturday Sept. 25 until closing ceremonies on the following Saturday, 12 noon. All vehicles must be out of camp 1 hour after gate closes. Opening ceremony is 7pm Friday 9/24. You MUST be in period clothes once your canvas is up **and at all times** in primitive camp from 9pm Friday 9/24, until closing ceremonies, Saturday 10/2 at 12 Noon.

Modern camps in modern camp area only, no hookups. Cozy Ridge Campground – 330-735-2553 for hookups. No camps of any sort in parking areas. Your medallion will be required to enter the rendezvous at all times. Entry in any event or voting requires your medallion.

NO ANIMALS other than horses and mules are permitted. Current health & negative Coggins Certificate will be required at the gate. You are responsible in all ways for the health, safety, conduct, and feed of your animals. Make sure that your animals are tolerant of the sight, sounds, and chaos of rendezvous! All tack, wagons, buggies, and accessories must be period appropriate. **No pets are allowed in primitive, modern, or parking lot areas**

Food Vendors: Contact Carroll Co. Board of Health, 330-627-4866, for licenses, 330-454-2078 for info.

Sutlers: You are responsible for contacting the Ohio ODNR, Ph. 330-644-2293, for information on what animal parts can be sold. You are also responsible for all collection of taxes or any permits needed. The Trade Captains decision is final. Trade blankets are subject to all Trade rules.

Wood, water, port-a-johns, and trash pickup provided. Ice sold daily. Hot showers at main barn, with fee.

Artillery Captain will inspect and approve all cannons before firing.

PRE-REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS AUGUST 24, 2010! PLEASE PRE-REGISTER!

Rendezvous fees include medallion, all events, seminars (make and take seminars may have a small cost), competitions, and camp dinner.

NMLRA member, spouse, or significant other pre-registraion is \$55.00 each. Non-members and significant other pre-registration is \$65.00 each. Dependants 18 and over (except spouse or partner) pre-registration is \$27.50 each. All children under 18 are FREE.

All registrations at the gate will be charges \$10.00 additional per adult/dependant.

Trader fees are \$35.00 (does not include registration). Please check trade rules. Commercial blanket trader fee in \$10.00 (does not include registration). Check trade rules for value amount of your trade goods allowed for all blanket traders.

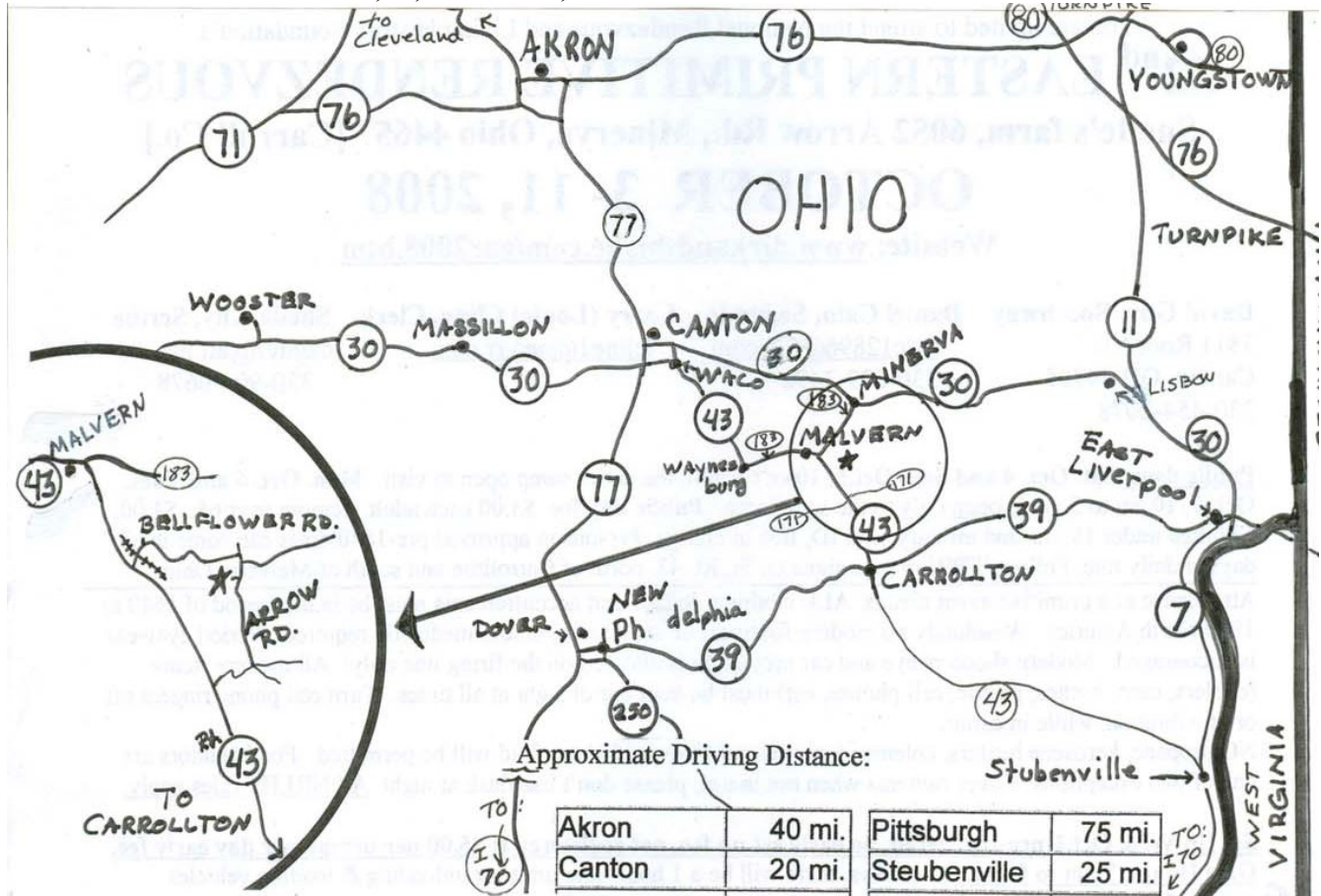

A camp store for your grocery needs will be located on the edge of Traders area. The camp meal will be Beef Chili or vegetarian veggie soup. Think of volunteering to help at rendezvous? Contact the Segundo or Scribe before the event or sign up at the gate when you come in.

From the N. East: take Rt.80 & Rt 76 to Rt. 11 South to Rt. 30 East to Minerva. Take 183/30 West at the center of Minerva. Follow to Rt. 43. At the Blue Colfor Plant turn left onto Rt. 43. Go about 4 miles to Bellflower that goes to the left. Turn left. Cross the RR tracks. Follow Bellflower, which is twisted, to Arrow Rd. Turn right and stay on Arrow to the EPR gate, about 100 ft. **From the S. East:** Rt 70 to 7 North, to 30 North, to Rt. 39 East, to Rt 43 North in Carrollton. Follow Rt. 43 for 4 or 5 miles to Bellflower that got to the RIGHT. Follow the final instructions as above.

From the West: Come in on Rt 80, 30, or 70 to I-77, follow the directions from North or South I-77.



From the South: take I-77 in E. Ohio to New Philadelphia/RT. 39 exit. Go East into New Philadelphia. Follow it through Carrollton, aprox. 25 mi. Turn left at Carrollton onto Rt.43 Follow the EPR signs on Rt 43 to Bellflower. Turn right. Cross the RR tracks and follow the road to Arrow Rd. Turn right and stay on Arrow Rd to the EPR gate. Gate is across the street from Snode's County Barn.

From the North: take I-77 South to the South side of Canton, OH. Take St. Rt. 30 East towards E. Liverpool. Turn right onto Rt. 43 to Waynesburg. Follow Rt 43 to the left at Waynesburg, to Malvern. Continue past Malvern. The road will take a right at the second light (at Colfor Plant.) Follow to Rt. 43 to Bellflower Rd. (approx. 3 miles) Turn left, cross the RR tracks, following the road to Arrow Rd. Turn right onto Arrow and stay on it until the EPR entrance. Watch for orange EPR signs!
